**July 2020 – Weinwisser**  
**17/20**

**June 2020 – James Suckling**  
**92-93/100**

This is a young red with serious concentration of fruit for the appellation, showing blue fruit and hints of dried mushrooms and salt. Full-bodied. Chewy finish. Better than the 2018.

**June 2020 – Vinous, Neal Martin**  
**91-93/100**

The 2019 Cap de Faugères has a typical Fronsac bouquet with dense blackberry, briary and melted tar aromas that kind of shut the door in your face for broaching it prematurely. I don't mind that - it's still delineated and develops an appealing loam character. The palate is medium-bodied with quite hard tannins, a broad-shouldered and grippy wine in the making with a potent briny finish. It will certainly require several years in the cellar, but it is still a Fronsac with character.

**June 2020 – Vert de vin magazine, Jonathan Chouckroun Chicheportiche**  
**92-93/100**

Le nez est fruité et offre de la puissance, une finesse du grain. On y retrouve des notes de cassis, de lys et plus légèrement de petits fruits sauvages associées à de petites touches de poivre gris ainsi qu'à une discrète pointe d'épices et de cacao. La bouche est fruitée, équilibrée et offre une trame juteuse/finement acidulée, de la gourmandise, de la suavité ainsi qu'une bonne définition, de la tension et une bonne structure. En bouche ce vin exprime des notes de cassis juteux/pulpeux, de petits fruits noirs et plus légèrement de lys/bleuet associées à de fines touches de prune noire pulpeuse, de framboise écrasée ainsi qu'à des pointes de cardamome, de fève de tonka et de toasté.

**June 2020 – The Wine Cellar Insider, Jeff Leve**  
**91-93/100**

Dark in color, the wine exudes licorice, smoke, dark chocolate, black pit fruits and cherries. Full-bodied, lushly textured and with a hedonistic, fruit and chocolate filled finish, this will offer a lot of bang for the buck. The wine was made from blending 80% old vine Merlot and 20% Cabernet Franc.

**May 2020 – Markus Del Monego**  
**92/100**

Dark purple colour with violet hue and black core. Quite classic nose with distinct fruit, reminiscent of ripe blackberries and blackcurrants, juicy black cherries and sweet elderberries. Subtle oak in the background. On the palate ripe yet firm tannins, fine
